KEY LIME PIE RECIPE

1 - Graham Cracker Crust

2 - 14 oz. Cans Sweetened Condensed Milk

1 1/4 - Cup Key Lime Juice

2 large eggs

TOPPING

2 Tbs - Powered Sugar 1/2 Cup- Sour Cream

Preheat oven to 325

Whisk together condensed milk, lime juice, and eggs until well blended. Pour into crust. Bake 18 to 20 minutes until set. Chill at least 4 hours.

Combine powdered sugar and sour cream. Spread evenly over pie.
