This includes the following: Rochester High School Scholarships - \$3,000, Hoosier wish for children fighting cancer - \$200, Compassionate Health Care - \$200, Junior Golf Clinic - \$200, Parade of nickels for veterans - \$150, Council on Aging - \$180, Sagamore Council Boy Scouts - \$100, Pack A Backpack program - \$100, Local Fireworks Fund - \$100, Eagle Scholarship Fund - \$100, Fulton County animal adoption center - \$75, Juvenile Correction Gardening Project - \$75, Nick Petterson "Field of Dreams" - \$25.

As you can see, your dues, along with your support of your Lodge, by dining here and playing golf here goes to helping our community. We believe in sponsoring and helping local needs and projects right here in Rochester, and Fulton County. Keeping this in mind, the more members, the more we can do.
